

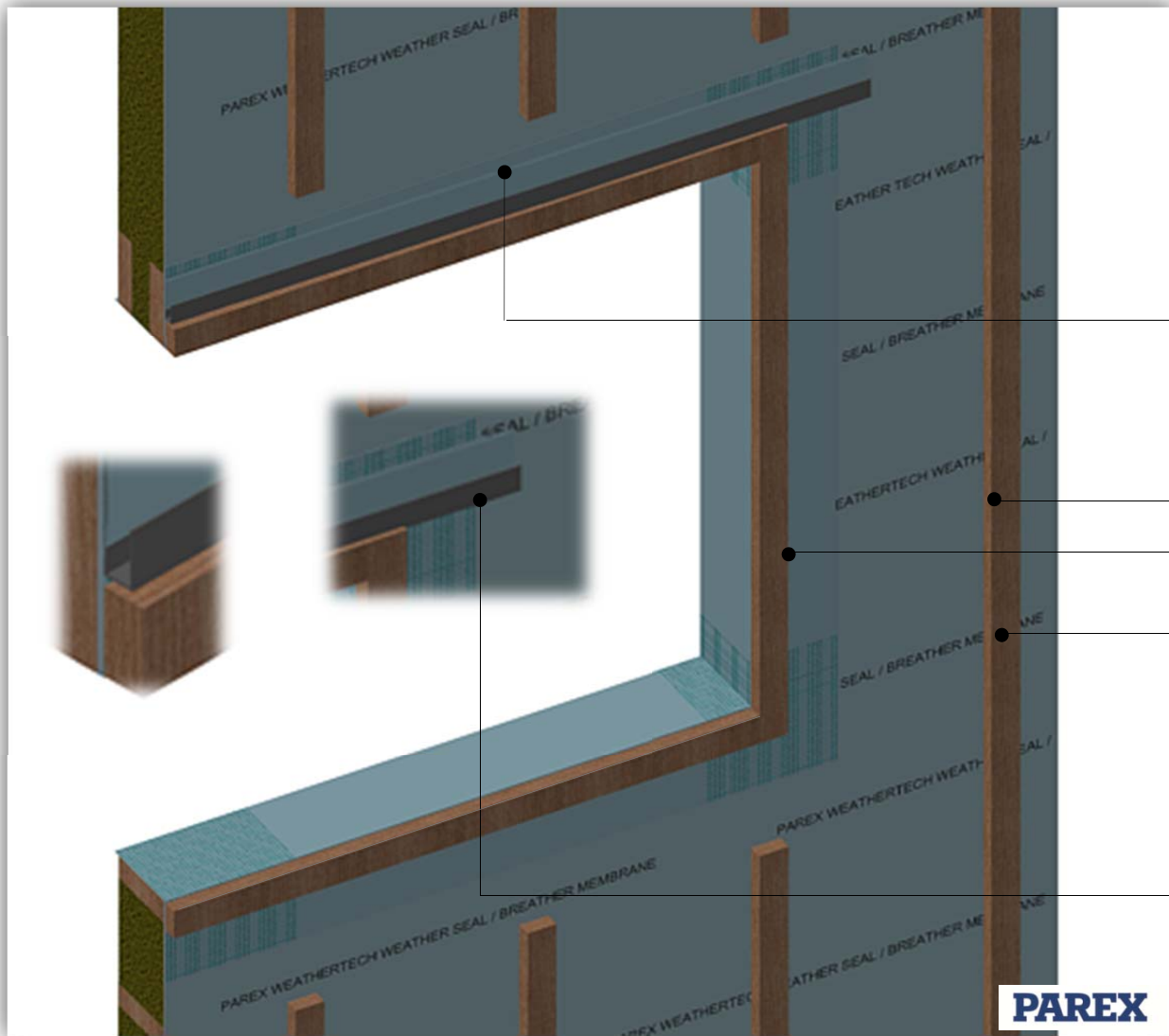
# PAREXDIRECT CAVITY ONTO TIMBER FRAME

WINDOW PROCEDURE 2 OF 5



This detail is for general guidance only and is not project specific. Always refer to the project architect details and the PAREX project specific specification.



Ensure the WeatherTech Weatherseal fully seals the breather membrane directly into the window / door head cavity deflection channel to prevent moisture gaining access into the building

Parex Weather Tech Weatherseal or proprietary breather membrane (by others, if required)

Cavity closer

Treated cavity batten (by others)

Aluminum window / door head drainage channel positioned at a slight angle (10mm fall) and fixed above the cavity closer with a minimum 50mm overhang at both ends

The general principles of this detail will apply to all forms of openings. For unusual applications contact Parex for additional guidance.

System: PAREXDIRECT onto Timber Frame

Application: Window installation 2 of 5 - Fitting of the cavity closers and window / door head cavity drainage channel
